ARE YOU SUFFERING OR WITNESSING ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR ?

Leeds Anti-Social Behaviour Team is working with Housing Leeds and West Yorkshire Police to tackle issues of Anti-Social Behaviour in the area by individuals or groups of people/youths.

We are working in partnership to tackle such unacceptable behaviour and have various methods for tackling these problems including Out of Hours Service to manage Noise Nuisance, diversionary activities and legal remedies including tenancy proceedings (council tenants only).

We wish to work with local residents to ensure such behaviour is dealt with swiftly and appropriately, but can only do that with the support of local residents and issues been reported to the correct Service Provider. Below are contact details on who and how to report such issues:

How do I report Noise Nuisance and Anti-Social Behaviour?

For Noise Nuisance: daytime tel. no. (0113) 2224406 or the Out of Hours Service between 18:00 – 03.30 on tel. no.(0113) 376 0337 which operates 7 nights a week.

To report a Crime or Criminal Activity you should call the police:

999 Emergency only / 101 Non-Emergency or 0800 555111 Crimestoppers (to give information on active criminals). West Yorkshire Police also now have on-line services including 'Clickb4ucall' and '101 Online Chat' to access these services log onto www.westyorkshire.police.uk.
