

## Walk 1 Short Riverside Walk

## 2 miles







Leaving the High Street turn down Deepdale Lane (next to Deepdale Community Centre) follow the road and you come to a public bridleway leading down to the riverside, take this path as it leads you along the side of a beck and through woodland. Admire the wonderful view of Jackdaw Crag, where the path reaches the river and then turn over the footbridge and climb up the steep slope as the footpath takes you along the top of the escarpment. From here you have beautiful views across the river to Thorp Arch Hall and surrounding farmland. The footpath continues at this high level then gently slopes down until you reach the meadow to the west of the river bridge. You can then continue along the riverside in an easterly direction (Walk 2) or turn back this time taking the lower level footpath that runs along the riverbank. From this lower level path you can see the weir and the old mill buildings at Thorp Arch. The lower level path stays close to the river before a steep climb brings you back to join the upper path where you can then retrace your steps over the footbridge and back up Deepdale Lane. There is an alternative path to the left as the path starts to drop down to the footbridge. If you follow this it will also take you back to Deepdale Lane.
