	<b>i</b>	<b>To consider any updates from correspondence received (Clerk)</b>
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• SALT have advised that the earliest time the brass band can start is 7pm</li><li>• Leeds Parking Services have confirmed that the 30-minute bays can be designated blue badge spaces for the duration of the event</li><li>• Jazz in the Spa have agreed to the lending of the A Board for the car park entrance</li><li>• The Village Hall have advised they will not be holding a Christmas market on the evening of the event, but that the hall will be made available in case of bad weather</li><li>• Martin House have been asked if they wish to participate and a response is being awaited.</li></ul>
	<b>ii.</b>	<b>To receive an update on the Christmas tree</b>
		Cllr Watts confirmed that Cllr Blake is looking a stand for the tree. Cllr Bowen asked if tree decorations could be applied before the tree is mounted due to its height.
	<b>iii.</b>	<b>To receive an update on Christmas tree lights and decorations</b>
		Cllr Bowen has contacted all of the schools in Boston Spa to see if they wish to design Christmas tree decorations. West Oaks have responded so far, and they would like to take part. Cllr Bowen asked for a budget of £500 for clear baubles which can be filled or decorated. The Committee agreed to take this forward to the next PC meeting for approval.
		<b>Resolved:</b> That a budget of £500 for tree decorations be requested at the October PC meeting.
	<b>iv.</b>	<b>To receive an update from choirs</b>
		Cllr Bowen confirmed she had written to all the schools and choirs in the locality. The Methodist Church would be happy to provide singers and asked if an organ/keyboard could be provided. Cllr Bowen agreed to contact Ken Waller. It was agreed that a gazebo would need to be mounted to provide some shelter from poor weather conditions.

		Cllr Courts advised that he had not yet spoken to the scouts. It was proposed that the Foodbank be approached to see if they wished to sell mince pies and Boston Bites be asked if they would open on the evening to provide hot drinks and other snacks.
