	Cllr Watts said she had tried to contact Kirby's and is awaiting a response. The tree size has been confirmed at 12ft. It was agreed that Cllr Watts would obtain a quote for a tree sponsorship sign if Kirby's do not have one. Cllr Blake has identified a heavy duty 3-legged tree stand for £137.49+VAT. Sandbags will be required at £15 each. New lights will be required and it was agreed these would be white. A quote had been obtained for a length of 120m (1,200 lights) at £340. Leeds lights will provide an extension to the tree from the uplighters in Millennium Gardens. It was proposed the tree be mounted the weekend before				

		the event, preferably on Sunday 30 <sup>th</sup> November. The Christmas lights on the High Street adjacent to Millennium Gardens will be switched off on the night to be switched on to coincide with the lighting of the tree. This will take place at 6pm. Cllr Blake said he would make a switch box.			
		<b>Resolved:</b> That the quote of £140 for a tree stand, £60 for sandbags and £340 for tree lights be approved.
